Street Level Photoworks mission statement is to “provide inspiring encounters with photography for all”.

We strive to maintain and develop new ways in which to broaden access to photography for the widest possible range of people as audiences, makers, and collaborators. This takes into account social economic background, cultural and religious background: existing barriers, both intellectual, physical and economic.

Getting Here

We are a short distance from Argyle Street low-level train station, 10 minutes from Queen Street station and Buchanan Street underground, and 15 minutes from Glasgow Central Station and St Enoch underground.

Visiting the Gallery

- Street Level Photoworks is a ground-floor, step-free accessible venue.
- The primary entrance to the gallery is via the Trongate 103 entrance, which has automatic wide double doors.
- Our main gallery double doors also allow for wider access, alongside our wider access emergency exit on Parnie Street.
- There is also a single-door side entrance to Street Level located at 26 King Street.
- Metered on-street parking can be found along Parnie Street and King Street and an NCP car park behind the gallery on King Street.

- There is a slight ramp between our two galleries and a ramp to our emergency exit.
- Our reception desk is accessible for wheelchair users and a wheelchair is available for visitors to use.
- There are two benches available for visitors to sit on, as well as two soft chairs.
- Guide dogs and support dogs are welcome in the gallery.
- No lift is required to access our galleries or production facilities.
- Our signage aims to assist those with visual impairment. Printed exhibition notes are provided in large print at the entrance to the gallery.
- QR codes are displayed for those choosing to download our information panels and there is extensive interpretation material to increase intellectual access and enrich the audience experience.

Toilet Facilities

- There is an accessible unisex toilet with an emergency pull cord and baby changing facilities close to the gallery in the main ground floor foyer of Trongate 103.
- For members and users of our production facilities, there is a unisex accessible toilet with an emergency pull cord plus one regular unisex toilet.

Access to Production Facilities

- The production facilities are located on the ground floor, off the main gallery space. We strive to make them accessible to as many people as possible.
- They are fully accessible for wheelchair users, with a lower-level sink in the darkroom, adaptable printing boards and lower work surfaces in the print finish area.
- All new members receive a thorough induction to the spaces and any additional needs can be discussed in this session.
- We offer concession rates for the unemployed, students, disabled and seniors to support greater access to those on low incomes.
